

# Explanation of the Storyboard event in July 2016.

Quite often a set of photographs can tell a better story than just a single one.

The idea behind the Storyboard project is to compile together a set of photographs to tell a story.

The author will present the story in July.

- The story can be audio visual or just visual.
- The story could be told by a set of prints which are displayed on the easels we have in the club.
- Or the story could be told digitally in an audio visual presentation.
- It could be narrated with words or without i.e. just a set of images.
- The words can be part of the presentation as in a PowerPoint slide show or using PicturestoExe or actually narrated by the author during the presentation to accompany the set of photos.
- You may want a transition from one photo to another (which can be done in PowerPoint or PicturestoExe).
- Or you may want to show a set of photos one after another, using Windows Photo Viewer.
- The story can take as long as is required. From 20 seconds to 5 minutes.
- Number of photos is up to you – enough to tell the story.
- Story topic is open.

So start to think about a topic for your Storyboard, plan it and start to take the photos which will be part of it.

There are only a few months to go!
